

1933

Our company dates back to the 1933's...

October 12th
Alberto Barale and **Atulio Maglione**
acquire the General Store of Las
Junturas.



1966

Luvio Maglione dies and **Juan Hector Maglione Jr.** joins as a new partner.



1968

The agricultural sector begins to be developed together with cattle breeding, producing mainly the **Hereford breed**.



1939

Juan Hector Maglione and **Luvio Maglione** join the partnership.



1976

The **first dryer of continuous flow** in the region is installed, becoming a great advantage for the sector.



1944

A new activity is incorporated: A cereal storage plant.



1978

The organization decides to seek progress by starting a new activity, **the production of H.P.S. Peanuts**, in a manual and very precarious way.



1954

The company consists of 12 employees whose head is **Atulio Maglione**. The first 54 acres of land are acquired for agricultural exploitation. A dairy farm with a daily capacity of 1300 litres is built.



1980

New machinery is incorporated for production: **eight monochromatic electrical channels Icore** imported from the United States are added to the line.



1962

Alberto Barale dies.



1990



A new plan of investments is developed in the cereal, H.P.S peanuts and cattle breeding sectors.

In this way, polychromatic channels are added to the peanut production. Silos, cells and new storehouses for cereals. Finally, the bovine breed is improved installing a livestock of pure reproductive breed called Polled Hereford.



1991

The company decides to produce H.P.S. confectionery peanuts, installing the first shelling machine.

This year also, the company starts exporting to the **international market**: trading 10% of the whole production.

1993



The peanut sectors continue to be developed by adding new machinery and **agricultural activities**, implementing field spraying services.

1995



A **Drying Peanut Plant** with the ultimate technology was built and also the shelling plant was restructured implementing high quality machinery.

1998



Elvira Ardhu withdraws from the firm giving way to a new generation of the family; this is when **Gustavo, Gastón** and **Nicolás Maglione**, sons of **Juan Hector Maglione Jr.** join the partnership.

2002



The firm changes its name to Corporation (Sociedad Anónima) thus, becoming Maglione Hnos y Cia S.A..

2005



Maglione Hnos y Cia S.A. through HACCP System and the international norm ISO 9001, produces under national and international norms, giving safe merchandise to our customers

2009



The organization experiences now the third generation from its beginnings, with 120 people working daily for the company.
